FLU ACTIVITY IN THE US

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), an estimated over 60,000 Americans died of influenza and its complications during the partial 2018-19 season (through May 4, 2019).

While the severity of last year's season was considered "moderate," it was a record-breaker as the longest flu season in the last decade. In addition, there were 136 pediatric deaths (18 yr & younger). This is the 6th highest number of flu-associated deaths in children reported during a regular flu season (since 2009-2010 season with 279 deaths). As in years past, the majority of pediatric deaths occurred in children who had not received a flu vaccination.

While there is no way to know how severe this season will be, there has already been one pediatric death reported. Read more: Flu Season Is Underway With Deaths Already Reported; Here's How to Prepare Yourself

Stay up to date: The CDC posts weekly influenza surveillance (FluView), an interactive FluView and current US flu activity map. This may be helpful in your communication to your students and community via email, and/or social media.




2018 Michigan Small School Winner Southwestern Michigan College


